How to Host an SDG Workshop

Workshop Length: 1.5-2 hours

Participants: Designed for key stakeholders and cross-departmental teams

STEPS

1. Select a Facilitator

> SELECT A LEADER WHO IS FAMILIAR WITH THE SDGS AND YOUR INDUSTRY WHO CAN ACT AS A NEUTRAL PARTY. THIS COULD BE SOMEONE INTERNAL OR EXTERNAL TO YOUR ORGANIZATION

2. Gather Orientation Materials & Send Invitations

- > PRE-READINGS: UN SDGS & Tourism
- > VIDEOS: UNWTO

3. Prepare Workshop Resources:

> SDG POSTERS – <u>UN SDG Graphics</u>

4. Host Your Workshop

- > REVIEW OUTCOMES FOR THE WORKSHOP AS A GROUP.
- > GROUP DISCUSSION: REVIEW THE 17 SDGs AND THEIR INDICATORS. WHICH ARE THE MOST SALIENT TO YOUR REGIONAL ISSUES/BUSINESS TYPE?
- > Dotmocracy Exercise: hand out post it notes and vote on the most relevant SDGs to your organization over the next 10 years
- > BREAKOUT ACTIVITY: CREATE TABLES FOR EACH OF THE TOP SDGS CHOSEN IN THE DOTMOCRACY. EACH TABLE DISCUSSES IDEAS FOR INTEGRATING THE SDGS INTO THE ORGANIZATION OVER THE NEXT 5 YEARS.
- $\,\,$ $\,$ Table Sharing: Each table shares their top 3 recommendations for forwarding the SDG at their table

5. Create a Plan
