Day 1








Day 2

Brunch and Victoria go hand-in-hand. In the city celebrated as Canada's Brunch Capital, there are many incredible options with restaurants that have perfected the careful art of a memorable brunch. We recommend taking the morning slow, sleeping in, then going to The Courtney Room for weekend brunch or breakfast. Here, old world meets new in an air of timeless elegance, with a menu that boasts the local community's fresh bounty. Indulge in their Crab & Gruyere Omelette or their delicious Smoked Salmon Benny to fuel up for your eventful day ahead.



Are you missing the incredible vistas from yesterday's arrival? Let <u>Harbour Air Seaplanes</u> lift you up on their panoramic sea-plane tour of our city. Take in the beauty of Victoria's twisting coastline, the Strait of Juan de Fuca and the majestic Olympic Peninsula before landing downtown in the Inner Harbour. There are options to book a private tour if you'd like the plane for yourself or the option to receive FlyGuide In-Flight Commentary, seating of your choice, and complimentary pre-or-post flight beverages as well.

For dinner, experience one of Victoria's newest fine dining establishments. The <u>Ugly Duckling</u>, located in historic Chinatown serves up delicious seasonally inspired dishes with local ingredients, that bring the local Chinese heritage to life in a refined tasting menu. Be sure to reserve your table at this intimate new restaurant.

After dinner, the city isn't done revealing it's secrets. You may need to solve a puzzle to enter this downtown speakeasy, but once you're in, you will have the opportunity to try over 200 whiskeys from around the world at <u>Artemis Whiskey Bar</u>. Whether you like your whiskey neat, or in an innovative cocktail, this place has it all, and does not hold back on style.









Day 3

Begin your morning with wellness in mind. In the summer, the Oak Bay Beach Hotel offers sunrise yoga classes at 8 AM, taught by their very own Spa Manager, Tina Lyons. Each hour-long class is delivered in a Hatha/Vinyasa style suitable for all ages and experience levels. The classes occur on the extraordinary Seaside Garden Terrace overlooking the Juan de Fuca Strait. If you're lucky, you may catch the occasional orca passing by!



Alternatively, beat the heat by teeing off in a morning golf session at <u>Highland Pacific Golf</u>. This picturesque course offers mountain views and beautiful holes that roll and wind through the highland hills. If you'd like to step it up a notch, you can also go to <u>Bear Mountain Resort</u>, which is home to 36 PGA-approved holes designed by Jack Nicklaus.



You've already had tee time, and now it's tea time! No trip to Victoria would be complete without indulging in a glamorous afternoon tea experience. Head over to The Pendray Inn and Teahouse, located on Victoria's scenic Inner Harbour, to enjoy a custom passed down for generations. The Pendray's relaxing ambiance is steeped in history & tradition, having been built in the 19th century in an authentic Victorian style. Paired with exotic and international teas and personable service, you're in for a lovely treat. After your meal, roam around the immaculately landscaped hotel gardens to work off your meal – deemed one of Victoria's most elegant wedding venues.



As the day comes to an end, get a taste of the west coast from 10 Acres Bistro; this hyper-locally sourced menu (mostly from their farm in nearby Saanich) is constantly changing to highlight the delicious island-raised ingredients that are most in-season. Order one of their hard-to-find wines or yet-to-be-discovered gems. Watch for their features you can't find anywhere else; your taste buds will thank you. If you opt for the patio, the ambiance might make your stay a little longer for a dessert or another delicious cocktail.





Day 4

On your final day, get your breakfast to go and escape to Greater Victoria's wine region in a custom, private tour in a comfortable Tesla. Alset Tours will pick you up from your hotel and take you on your own personal Itinerary. To start your day with stunning views, visit the Malahat SkyWalk for an unbeatable view of the Saanich Inlet and Peninsula and some crisp forest air.



Return to your Tesla for your Craft Vine, Orchard & Stills tour, taking you to eight different Saanich Craft orchards and vineyards. Deep Cove Winery, Sea Cider Farm & Ciderhouse, and Church & State Wines are just some of the few delectable options you will sample as you take in the natural wonders of the Saanich Peninsula.
