If you'd prefer a taste of the sea, go to <u>Barb's Fish & Chips</u>, where you can grab some delicious fish & chips on the wharf.

Explore the quirky side of Victoria at Fisherman's Wharf. Only a short walk away from the inner harbour, you'll find a colourful floating house community with many local artisanal shops to visit.



For the active types, <u>Kelp Reef Adventures</u> is available for guided kayak tours of the Inner Harbour where you will view the local marine life, like seals, otters, and countless bird species. Your knowledgeable guide will also share many fun facts about the area as you navigate this unique natural waterway.



After all that paddling, it might be time for a well-deserved patio beer. Enjoy some delicious local creations at <u>Whistle Buoy Brewing</u> in the heart of downtown. Located in a classic downtown Victoria courtyard, you will be right by Lower Johnson Street, a great place to explore Victoria's boutique shopping.
