Victoria International Airport to Welcome New Non-Stop Service to Montreal

(Victoria, BC) Victoria Airport Authority (VAA) today announced that Air Canada will offer three times weekly non-stop service between Victoria (YYJ) and Montreal (YUL) utilizing a 136 seat Airbus 319 (A319). Service is scheduled to begin June 22, 2018.
